This term's topic in Year 1 is 'Explorers'. If you have any artefacts or books or photographs, please send them in, so that your child can share them with their class.

English

In English, our focus text will be Bold Women in Black History and we will be focusing on writing non-fiction biographies. We will consolidate our learning of using simple punctuation, adjectives, similes and factual information headings.

Maths

Our maths learning this half term includes:

Numbers 0-20 - Representing and comparing numbers from 0 to 20 and using those numbers in the context of measure. Unitising and coin recognition - Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Recognising coins and notes and adding up coins. Time - Telling the time on the hour (o'clock) and half hour (half past), writing time and comparing time using vocabulary such as 'before' and 'after'.

Science

In science, we will be **comparing materials**. The children will have the opportunity to make close observations of the properties of these materials and group them according to similarities and differences. The children will also be carrying out simple comparative tests.

History

This term's topic is 'Explorers' and will be looking at different explorers throughout history. We will be researching facts about a range of explorers including: Mae Jemison, Amy Johnson, Ranulph Fiennes and Christopher Columbus. Whilst learning about Christopher Columbus, we will be touching on slavery. You might like to use this as moment to discuss identity, race and discrimination with your child.

PSHE

This half-term's PSHE unit is focused around Economic Wellbeing, where the children will explore different ways to keep money safe and recognise that people may make different choices about spending or saving.

DT - COOKING + NUTRITION:

Fruit and veg for smoothie - handling and exploring fruits and vegetables, and learning how to identify which category they fall into, before undertaking taste testing to establish their chosen ingredients for their own smoothie.
