LEARNING CONTINUES ...

<u>WRITING</u>

Over the next few weeks, we will be using Varmints, a short story and film about an environmental catastrophe, to explore how atmosphere can be created and suddenly changed so that our reader goes on a poignant and tense journey with our main characters. By the end of the topic, the children will plan and write their own disaster story involving a wild fire.

MATHS

Our maths learning this half term includes:

- Ratio
 - Algebra

<u>SCIENCE</u>

The children will conclude their science in Year 6 focusing on light and sight. Expect lots of practical experiments where the children explore how light travels, why shadows change and how they are formed, as well as understanding how we see objects.

<u>HISTORY</u>

This half-term, we will be starting a British Empire topic. The learning will mainly have a history focus as we explore why Britain once ruled the largest empire the world has ever seen. We will also explore the cultural impact of the empire, looking at influences in art and music and how it's evolved over time.

<u>PE</u>

This half-term, the focus will switch to athletics and outdoor and adventurous activities (OAA). Please ensure that your child comes appropriately dressed for PE on the day of their lessons and is ready for any sessions that are planned for off-site, e.g. Peckham Rye Park:

6A - Wednesdays and Fridays

HOME LEARNING

Although home learning will look a little bit different this half-term, it continues to be an important part of Year 6 as we begin to prepare the children for secondary school. Here are some examples of tasks that the children may be asked to complete:
