Governing Body Update From Ros Tuerk

Our update last term was from our chair, Simon Edwards, however we thought it would be helpful for you to hear from different members of the governing body with different roles. One of my specific roles on the governing body is as the link governor for safeguarding. This means I help to monitor that the schools are carrying out all of their statutory responsibilities in this area. We heard in detail at our last meeting about all the different processes and activities that the staff undertake to keep your children safe and were really impressed with just how much the schools do in this regard. This includes working with an external organisation around online safety, and we would encourage you all to attend the parent workshops which will be taking place around this in September. Another of the activities we undertake as a governing body is looking at outcomes and progress data across both schools and speaking to the heads and staff team about the story that data tells us – celebrating the areas that are going well, and looking at the plans the schools have to develop in other areas. As part of this we visit both schools each term; on this term's visit we had the pleasure of hearing from a range of children across all year groups about their science learning and their enthusiasm for science and seeing all the evidence of this in their books. Finally, we would like to congratulate the whole Fairlawn community on the outcome of their recent Ofsted inspection. As governors we had the opportunity to meet with the inspector (as we did for the Haseltine inspection last year), and share our thoughts on the school. We hope you were as pleased reading the report as we were; we thought it was an excellent reflection on the school, and on Haseltine too, given how closely the schools work together. We wish you all a lovely summer holiday, and we will write to you again towards the end of the Autumn term with another update.
