For Nursery children, the cost of a lunch per day is £2.50. Please pay via ParentPay. Please be aware that packed lunches should not contain Nuts, Sweets, Chocolate Bars, Fizzy Drinks, or Peanut Butter/Nutella Sandwiches. Punctuality

School starts at 8:45am. Your child will be marked as late if they arrive after 8:55am. If your child arrives 10 minutes late every day, that adds up to almost an hour of school lost every single week!

If you have not arrived by **4pm**, your child will go into After School Club as an emergency place, where you will be charged **£12**.
