Having enjoyed writing about <i>The Crow's Tale</i> last term, Year 2 will now be exploring both fiction and non-fiction within their writing lessons in spring 1. We will explore non-fiction biography writing through the life of <b>Grace</b> <b>Darling</b> , the daughter of a lighthouse keeper who bravely saved many lives during a horrific storm off the coast of Northumberland in 1838. We will then revisit narrative writing through the twisted tale: <i>Little Red Reading Hood</i> by Lucy Rowland based on <i>Little Red Riding Hood</i> . In this version, Little Red Reading Hood loves reading books and making up stories of her own when she meets a cunning wolf while on her way to the library.
